The Glacial Heritage Area (GHA) located in Jefferson, Dane, Dodge and Rock Counties, is a coordinated series of parks, preserves, wildlife and natural areas linked together and to nearby cities and villages with different types of trails.

This network of "strings and pearls" will provide readily accessible opportunities for residents and visitors to get outdoors to hike, bike, watch wildlife, fish, paddle, hunt, camp, cross-country ski, ride horses, and participate in other nature-based activities.

Equally important, the GHA will work to protect and restore native grassland, savanna, woodland, and wetland habitats, and improve water quality in lakes, wetlands, and rivers.

The GHA aims to incorporate the area's significant cultural and historical elements for the enjoyment of all.
